Title I is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education. Title I is part of ESEA (Elementary & Secondary Education Act) signed into law in 1965 by President Lyndon Johnson. In December 2001, President Bush signed into law the "No Child Left Behind Act".

The goal of Title I is to improve student achievement through:

- ◆ Effective instruction
- ◆ Professional Development
- ◆ Family Engagement

Title 1 schools use their funds for a variety of items, including the following:

- ◆ Highly qualified instructional personnel
